



BUILDING MAINTENANCE HANDYMAN

Position Summary:

The Building Maintenance Handyman reports directly to the Warehouse Manager. Performs a variety of skilled duties in the Turning Point International Headquarters building, such as painting, carpentry, minor electrical, cement masonry, dry wall or other recognized trades for the purposes of maintaining and repairing the facility, H.V.A.C. and other mechanical systems a plus.

Essential Functions:

- Assist as directed in the repair and maintenance of all aspects of the property, including plumbing, heating, ventilating, air conditioning, automatic temperature controls, electrical, etc.
- Perform preventative maintenance procedures on a scheduled basis
- Repair doors and door locks; clean windows
- Complete daily, weekly, and monthly checklists on building maintenance procedures and maintain records of scheduled maintenance procedures
- Use computer to receive direction and scheduling through email and to keep current records of maintenance projects
- May recommend purchases and cost saving measures and obtain estimates for supplies, repair parts, and order parts as needed
- Perform weekly safety checks throughout the facility to ensure a safe and clean environment and eliminate all hazards according to OSHA standards
- Respond to emergency maintenance requests as required
- Perform custodial duties as required

Qualifications:

- Must have a valid California Driver's License
- Ability to follow written and verbal instructions

- One year of responsible experience in building maintenance and repair

Physical Demands:
